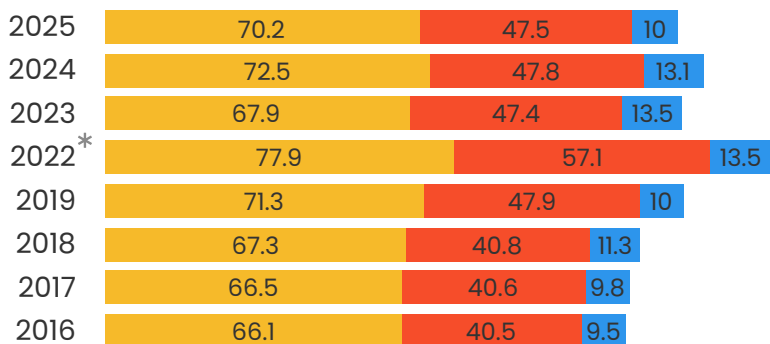
Our Y11 students have once again achieved exceptional results. We continue to exceed expectations, with Yateley School's results being significantly above national averages.

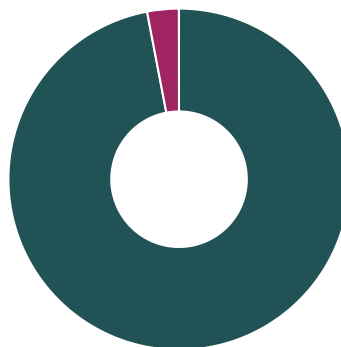

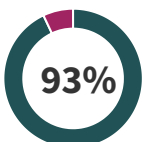
WHO WE ARE AND... HOW WE COMPARE!
